UPDATE: Questions for Sheriff Tim Cameron:

- 1. WHAT DAY DID YOUR AGENCY FIRST COME IN CONTACT WITH THE SUSPECTS WHO WERE ARRESTED? WAS IT LAST FRIDAY?
- 2. WHAT HAPPENED TO THE GUNS THE TEENS HAD ACCESS TO BETWEEN THE TIME YOU FIRST FOUND THE GUNS AND WHEN THE SEARCH WARRANT WAS EXECUTED?
- 3. ARE THE SUSPECTS RELATED TO ANYONE IN THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT?

ANSWERS FROM ST. MARY'S SHERIFF TIM CAMERON

- Patrol officers initially made contact with the suspects during the initial threat assessment late Thursday night into Friday morning the 16th.
- 2. All accessible firearms were collected when the search warrant was conducted.
- Yes, one of the suspects is related to someone in the agency; no one involved in the investigation had any relation to, or any conflict of interest, with any of the suspects.

- With collaboration from the State's Attorney's Office and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF)-Baltimore Field Office, several search warrants were obtained. - Two arrests have been made in reference to this investigation; two male
 juveniles ages 15 and 16, of Leonardtown, were charged with Threat of
 Mass Violence, and a warrant has been issued for David William Fairfax, age
 39, of 23258 Jenifer Court. Leonardtown, for the following charges; two
 counts of Reckless Endangerment, one count of Access to a Firearm by a
 Minor, and one count of Illegal Transfer of a Firearm.
- Dave Fairfax lists on his Facebook page that he is the COO of
- F4 Defense and works for the U.S. Navy at Patuxent River NAS. He has been identified as the father of one of the teens arrested and charged with threats of mass murder.
